

ALSTOM T&D APPOINTS NEW HIGH VOLTAGE SWITCHGEAR  
BUSINESS MANAGING DIRECTOR

**D**aniel Peloquin will become the managing director of the Charleroi, PA, High Voltage Switchgear business unit on November 1, 2003.

A Canadian citizen, he graduated from Ecole Polytechnique de Montreal, and holds a bachelor of engineering degree with a specialty in power systems.

Although he began his career as a project manager in the steel industry, he was quickly attracted to the manufacturing segment, and joined a manufacturer of medium voltage switchgear equipment in 1983. He served in positions of increasing responsibility, first as a project manager and ultimately as head of the engineering department. (This business would later become ALSTOM's medium voltage switchgear unit in Montreal, when ALSTOM purchased Cegelec in 1998).

In 1989, Mr. Peloquin joined a large manufacturer of power systems equipment as product manager for protection and control systems, and in 1993, joined ALSTOM's High



Voltage Switchgear business in Montreal, as circuit breakers product manager. In 1996, he was named commercial director, and was promoted to managing director three years later. Since 2000, he has concurrently served as Country Manager for Transmission & Distribution (T&D) in Canada.

In addition, he also serves on the executive committee and is a member of the board of directors, ALSTOM Canada.
